The Crisis Nursery serves children birth to 6 years of age that are at-risk of abuse and neglect. Each ministry team member will cover 1 shift a month on Saturdays between the hours of 4-8 pm. If some reason a volunteer team member cannot cover their assigned shift, other team members will share coverage amongst themselves. Volunteers spend time playing with children, rocking babies, or supervising children while they play with each other.
