LCM News "ticker" - is located on the upper right section of the LCM Home page. The ticker contains a short message about the LCM News events in a scrolling window. You can click on any of the events as they scroll to go directly to that news item in the LCM News page. The news ticker is a feed from the LCM News page. You can also click on the link



LCM News detail page - is the detail of the LCM News items. Think of this as a simple "blog" page. Each news item is a post to which an individual or group of users record opinions. information, etc. on a regular basis. Anyone can add a comment to any of the news items by clicking on the "Add Comment" link below the specific news item. You can also share the post in Twitter or Facebook by simply clicking on the respective icon below the specific news item. Another feature on the LCM News page is an RSS feed link that will allow you to setup feeds directly to your own personal RSS application you may have on your mobile device or personal computer without having to go in to the LCM webpage.
