Revitalizing Your Congregation: Meeting will be held at LCM at 7:00 PM, Tuesday, October 29.

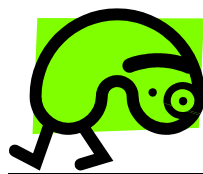
