**Don't Miss This**: Guest Speaker, Nathan Montgomery, Executive Director of Salt and Light Ministry in Champaign, IL will be addressing the congregation at the services on Sunday, September 22. Salt and Light is a ministry which provides food and other resources to families in need. The ministry took its name from Matthew 5:13-14: <sup>13</sup> "You are the salt of the earth; but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trodden under foot by men.

<sup>14</sup> "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. <sup>15</sup> Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a bushel, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. <sup>16</sup> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

**Mid September Call Process Update:** On Sunday, September 15 Pastor Blobaum gave his sermon on the account of the shepherd leaving his flock to search for the one lost sheep. As Pastor Blobaum spoke, I related his message to our ongoing process in seeking a permanent pastor for our family. In my heart, I felt a bit like the lost sheep waiting for the Shepherd to find us. For me, I concluded that though we might have the normal reaction to "keep moving" in hopes of finding where we are going, in this circumstance we are best to "stay put". Yes, we are anxious. Yes, we would have liked to have had a new pastor in place by this time. But, the true Shepherd knows our need. He is searching for the one that can lead our flock. If we move too quickly, the one may not find us. We must "stay put" and continue to have faith and trust in God's plans for The Lutheran Church of Mahomet. That's my plan. I hope we can share it together.

The Call Committee has had an initial interview with a pastor candidate and the interview went very well. The candidate has accepted our invitation to return in the next couple of weeks and we remain positive about the process. God calls us to be active participants in seeking him out. Please continue to keep this process, the call committee members and the candidate in your daily prayers. God has a plan for LCM. We will stay put. And THEN, we will rejoice in being found.
