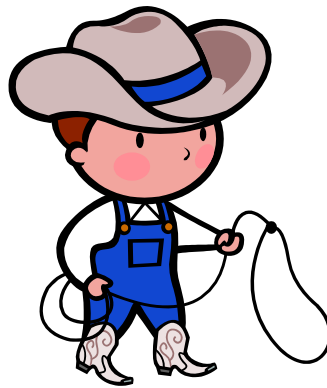

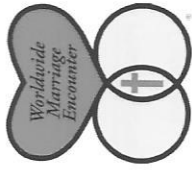

Who can attend?

- A man and woman who are married to each other, regardless of their religious beliefs. There is no attempt to encourage anyone to adopt Christian beliefs.
- Being married at least 2 years will help you receive the maximum benefit.

What happens?

- A Marriage Encounter Weekend consists of:
- A series of talks focused on various aspects of a marriage relationship presented in a conference room by Weekend leadership couples, including a clergy person and spouse.
 - The program progresses from 8:00 pm Friday through 4:30 pm Sunday, so it's important to attend the entire Weekend to receive its full benefit.

What about our privacy?

- You will listen to talks along with other couples attending the Weekend.
- After each talk, the two of you will return to your hotel room alone to privately share your thoughts and feelings about each topic.
- You are never required to openly share with the group.

- An application fee of \$45.00 per couple is required when you submit your application.
- This fee can be transferred to a different Weekend if you are unable to attend the Weekend you originally request.
- Toward the end of your Weekend, you are given an opportunity to make a confidential contribution of whatever amount you wish toward the continuation of Marriage Encounter through the Lutheran Expression.
