<u>Central/Southern Illinois Synod (C/SIS) Assembly:</u> The twenty-sixth annual <u>Central/Southern Illinois Synod</u> (C/SIS) Assembly will meet at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, Springfield, IL on June 6-8,

2013. The theme for this year's assembly is "Blessed to be a Blessing". Featured presenters include: The Rev. Susan Briehl, a Lutheran pastor and author; Ms. Else Thompson, Executive for Human Resources for the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America; and Mr. Robert Sampson, a musician/song writer/singer.

A festival worship service will be held at the Church of the Little Flower on Thursday, June 8, 2013 beginning at 8:00 p.m. The Rev. Dr. S. John Roth, bishop of the Central/Southern Illinois Synod, will preach and preside at the service. The Rev. Dr. Robert T. Dealey will be installed as the C/SIS Director of Evangelical Mission and there will be recognition of Synodical Authorized Ministries. A special offering will be received in conjunction with the worship service to support the ministries of the Lutheran Church Madagascar. The public is invited to attend the Thursday worship service.

More than 500 voting members and visitors will attend the assembly. In addition to conducting business that comes before the assembly, 11 different forums on a variety of ministry topics will be offered. Among those attending from Lutheran Church of Mahomet are: Interim Pastors Victor Baderschneider and Emil Blobaum; Bill Moehring, delegate and Dia Nuesmeyer, delegate; Kendyl Cummins, Youth Delegate; and Larry Gibson, IT Specialist for the C/SIS Assembly.

The Central/Southern Illinois Synod is comprised of 132 congregations in 76 of the 102 Illinois counties. The synod has over 45,000 baptized members and is one of the sixty-five synods of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.




