## Holy Week Services: Sunday of the Passion: March $24^{\text {th }}$ 9:00 AM

Palm Sunday is a day of contradictions. We begin worship remembering Jesus' triumphal procession into Jerusalem, in which the people of the City welcome Him with joy as a reforming king. By the end of the service, however, the mood of jubilation has turned to one of solemnity, as we focus on Jesus' suffering and death at the hands of a disappointed mob. Clearly Jesus is not the kind of king people wanted.

What we want for ourselves ultimately stands in conflict with God's solution. And it is God himself who, in His passionate love for us, works out this contradiction on the cross. He will reconcile a sinful humanity to Himself through this once-for-all payment. Let us come and stand in awe of His amazing love for us, this Holy Week!

Maundy Thursday Worship: March $28^{\text {th }}$ 6:30 PM
A service of Holy Communion will be held on Maundy Thursday, March $28^{\text {th }}$ at 6:30 PM. On Maundy Thursday we remember the Lord who came to us as a humble servant. He gives us His life so that we may live a new life, and gives us a new commandment: that we love one another as He has loved us.

Good Friday Tenebrae Service: March $29^{\text {th }}$ 6:30 PM
On Good Friday we will share in a Tenebrae ("shadows") service in remembrance of our Lord's complete sacrifice for us on his cross. This solemn service reminds us of the reality of sin and evil in
